John Jordan is a woodturner from Cane Ridge (Nashville), Tennessee. Known primarily for his textured and carved hollow vessels, John has been featured in nearly every major turning exhibition the past twenty years. His work has received numerous awards, and is in the permanent collections of many museums and corporations.

John is in great demand as a demonstrator/teacher, traveling extensively teaching at universities, craft schools, turning groups and trade shows throughout the US, Canada, the UK, France, New Zealand, Australia and Japan.

His work is frequently seen in publications in several countries as well as articles written by him. In addition to his most recent video on the aesthetics and properties of wood, he has also produced two previous best selling woodturning videos, which received very favorable reviews.

tics, and an easily cleaned floor. Eric welcomed four guests and one new member before turning the meeting over to Bill Kruger. Bill demonstrated inside out turning. Bill used the technique to create a Christmas ornament. Bill used green painters tape to hold the four pieces together while turning the initial stage of his work. He then separated those four segments, rotated each 180 degrees about its long axis and glued them together before turning the final outside shape to match the inside curve.

After the demonstration and a short break Eric spoke about the Wednesday night workshops at Tim Rowe's shop. Please let Tim know by email before attending a workshop so that he and the instructors can plan for the number of students attending.

Eric also talked about John Jordan's demo and hands on October 15. See the feature article for more info.

Our January meeting will feature an all day demonstration by Rudy Lopez. March 24-26, 2012 we will host a demonstration and hands on with David Ellsworth. Tim Rowe spoke about the agreement with the Boca Raton Recreation department to provide classes beginning this January. A motion was made and seconded to spend \$1400 to purchase two additional Delta midi lathes with accessories to use at the classes. After discussion Eric called for a vote and the purchase was approved.
